

# THE BIG CREEK Watershed Day



A watershed is an area of land that drains all the surface water and rainfall to a common outlet. In our case, that's the Big Creek Estuary, where Big Creek enters Sturgeon Bay at The Cove Preserve. Our watershed—the Big Creek Watershed—covers 6,253 acres, or 9.8 square miles.
